Sports' Registration

All athletes must be registered in order to participate. If you have not registered, you may do so at any time. You may not participate until your registration is complete including an updated physical. A picture of your physical needs to be updated to the site. Go to https://wbsd-ar.rschooltoday.com to create or update your account. Athletes must be registered yearly. You will need your student ID which can be found in your Skyward account (other ID). Impact Testing

If you still need to take an Impact test you may do it at home! Please let Mrs. Nier (<u>cnier@wittbirn.k12.wi.us</u>) know if you would like to do this and include the athlete's name and

grade. If you do not complete your impact test prior to the first day of practice, you will not be allowed to practice until it is complete.

ImPACT is a neurocognitive test battery that provides healthcare professionals with objective measure of neurocognitive functioning as an assessment aid and in the management of concussion in individuals ages 12-59. Athletes are tested every two years through an internet based test, giving a baseline for healthcare professionals to compare if there is a suspected head injury.

Spectators
