## **PK-12** Instructional Update

Hello WB families! Our 4k-8 grade staff have compiled a variety of grade level resources and activities that your students can engage in between March 17th and April 5th. These activities are designed to supplement your students' learning during the mandated closure and can be found on our school website. Should the closure window extend beyond April 5th, 2020, the WB District will provide our families with a structured virtual learning plan, including academic curriculum, and learning objectives specifically designed for your student. We are currently preparing to return to normal school activities on April 6th, 2020, however, our staff are currently preparing for beyond that date. Students in grades 9-12 will be moving to a virtual learning platform on March 30th at 8:05am. Students will utilize their school provided chromebooks to access required/necessary information. Grade level and subject area teachers will be communicating with students via email on or before April 6, 2020 to communicate necessary information related to their specific classes.

All special education teachers will be contacting individual families and students regarding specific services. Teachers are planning to implement instruction/services on an individual basis. In the event that you do not have internet at home:

- Wittenberg Telephone Company has graciously offered a free wifi hotspot at their office location of 104 West Walker Street, named: WittenbergHOTSPOT, it is up 24 hours a day. Feel free to stay in your vehicle to continue social distancing and complete any work.
- If you live in the Wittenberg Telephone Service area, they have volunteered to install free internet for 60 days. Families are asked to report this to the school district by calling the district office at 715-253-2213, please leave a message with your name, phone number and address. The district will in turn share this information, with the Wittenberg Telephone Company.
- Work with your child's grade/subject area teachers to obtain hard copies of instructional/required materials
