What is Title I?

Title I is a federally-funded program that provides qualifying schools with financial support for additional instruction in math and reading for children at risk. As a Title I district we need to develop a plan for addressing our needs in these areas.

Our data shows that
over the last several years, the
percentage of Witt-Birn third graders
scoring "proficient" on the WI
Forward Reading Assessment has
been below the state average.

Research shows that students not reading at grade level by the end of third grade are highly likely to remain poor readers, tend to have social and behavioral problems in later grades, and have a higher rate of retention.

Our Goal:

By the end of the 2022-2023 school year, the number of Wittenberg-Birnamwood third grade students who reach the proficient level on the WI Forward Reading Assessment will match the state average.

What's Next?

Over the next year we will be working on K-3 curriculum and assessment practices that will help our students improve their reading achievement.
