Scholarship Fund

The Mid-State Football and Cheerleading program offers a scholarship for eligible students who participated in a Mid-State program (Mid-State Pop Warner or Mid-State Youth Football and Cheerleading). The scholarship fund will provide five separate scholarships of \$250 each to eligible graduating seniors.

To be eligible the applicants must:

1. Completed at least one (1) year in a Mid-State Program.
2. Be accepted into an accredited college and plan to attend in the fall of the year the scholarship is awarded.
3. Complete an essay that includes:
 - a. The benefits derived from participation in their respective activity at the Mid-State Conference level.
 - b. The benefits derived from participation at the high school level.
 - c. Anticipated benefits later in life as a result of participation.

Complete and mail your scholarship application no later than Monday, **April 16th, 2018**. Only applications received with a postmark no later than **April 16th, 2018** are eligible. Mail your application to:
